A presentation was given by Valerie and Suzette, representatives from Baylor Scott & White Oncology. May is Melanoma month. Early detection and prevention is key. Protect your scalp with a brimmed cap, long sleeves-darker and tighter weave is better. Wear sunscreen. Sun glasses that don't list UV A or UV B protection should be assumed to have no protection. Protect your children's eyes with sunglasses as well. Other skin cancers exist besides Melanoma but Melanoma is the biggest concern. Watch for a spot/mole that is changing in color, symmetry, size or border. A new spot/mole that you have not had in the past should be looked at. Individuals with fair skin, green or blue eyes or burn easily are at greater risk. Overcast skies do not mean you are not getting sun. Recommendation is to never leave the house without sunscreen. They brought sunscreen and lip balm samples to share.
