- 1. April 8, 2021 meeting minutes approved.
- Treasurer's Report Donna Childress reported a balance of \$4362.04. Putt money is now at \$339.75. A \$463.00 invoice for Sadie Hawkins was paid and \$720 for the Ryder Cup dinner.
- 3. Joan Ray is addressing family matters but is still continuing in her role of Hospitality Chair.
- 4. Play Day Chair Elaine Dobos reported a good year with games and participation.
- 5. Central Texas Ladies Golf League report from Jill Marangoni indicated 3 participants at the most recent competition at Delaware Springs. Our group will be hosting the November play day.
