1. Angelina Vinson, our new Golf Head Professional, joined our group to introduce herself and to express her commitment to working with the WGA. Angelina provided some follow-up on the course conditions discussed with Matt, Brad and Cassidy.
  - a. Under discussion to move the #1 tee box rather than mow back further toward the tee box a bit because the rough does not allow some women to make it to the fairway. If shortening the hole the character of the hole and its Par 5 element would change significantly.
  - b. Number 8 short and narrow apron to the green will be addressed.
  - c. Number 15 will be addressed at the area before the creek, making it level. Also, the area to the right of the creek up to the cart path will be leveled. The fairway apron leading up to the green will be widened to provide a better landing area. This will be a project for next year.
  - d. Angelina will ask to revisit Number 10 as the fairway is a long distance from the women's tees. Also, the fairway leading up to the green will be examined to see if it can be widened.
2. Wildflower will be hosting the CTLG tournament on November 4<sup>th</sup>. For our members it will be \$13 with \$5 if players want to participate in the game. Request was made to have spotters on Hole 1 and Hole 7 to keep up pace of play. Also requested to have clear Ground Under Repair markings as the visiting players already struggle with the difficulty of our course. We will need assistance with volunteers to help players load their clubs on carts, and check in at registration.
3. The minutes from the September 9<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.
4. The budget began at \$4362 and the putt money of \$165 was added. The food invoice of \$479 for the Sadie Hawkins tournament was paid as well as a few related minor items reimbursed. The current balance is \$4048.45. The Hole in One money is at \$290, Putt money at \$425 and Play day funds at \$620.
5. Joan Ray reported to the group that she continues to send cards and will submit her invoice at the end of the season. Joan agreed to continue in this position for next year and Mary Celentani expressed the appreciation of our group for Joan's willingness to assist with registration and other duties throughout the season.
6. Elaine Dobos reported there are only two more play dates – October 21 and 23-the pink ball game will be used as it was rained out this past play day. Tee times for 9:00 on Thursdays and 10:00 on Saturdays will continue but players must call in so the correct number of times are reserved for the group.
7. The Boo Bash is to be held October 30. Awards for best cart decoration, best team costume, and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the scramble will be presented. There will also be "wicked" games on the course. Afterward there will be a BBQ at Elaine's home. It is a BYOB event. Several members are bringing desserts and others are welcome to do so. Nancy Armstrong is preparing her traditional treat bags. There will also be games and

prizes at the event. There is a \$35.00 entry fee. Signups close the Wednesday prior to the event.

8. Sam Wright's last day at the club is Sunday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. Mary Celentani will take care of a farewell card and gift. Josh and Derek will remain on staff and a new person, Daniel, will also come on board.
